 just last year June 29/07 my husband
 fell off of a ladder while trimming our hedge
 & landed on some garden timbers in the neighbour
 yard! He managed to hobble back into the
 basement & called to me (wife Edith) he was in
 "terrible pain" & could not stand up straight so
 I knew I had to call the ambulance, they
 arrived shortly after I called & gave them a
 quick review of what happened they also
 brought 5th floor man to lift him onto

the stretcher as we did not know how
 serious the injury was, there was a male
 & a female paramedic. He was in hospital
 for 9 days in Mission Hosp was well taken care
 of & was also sent to Burnaby Gen Hosp. for
 more tests (body scan?) & I was asked to
 go along in the ambulance as it was expected
 he would be there for several hrs. from around 9 AM
 arrived back in Mission by 7 PM. He had



a bruise the size of a water melon
 fractured # 92 vertebrae & 2 cracked
 ribs & internal bleeding. At the age
 of 75 is doing fairly well but has
 always had some back problems.

Also in 1984 when we lived in Abbotsford
 he had a mild heart attack was
 sent by ambulance to Abb. Hosp. but
 I don't remember the Paramedics.
